CISF in metro: ₹22.7L returned, 69 kids reunited this year

New Delhi: Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) personnel deployed in Delhi Metro have intercepted five attempts to smuggle illegal weapons, returned over Rs 22.7 lakh in lost valuables and reunited 69 children with their families so far this year.

Officials said commuters often lose bags in crowded stations, but CISF teams

traced and returned belongings worth Rs 22.7 lakh, including Rs 15.7 lakh in cash and a cheque of Rs 7 lakh. "Foreign currencies belonging to international tourists, including 80 British pounds, 6,000 Nepalese Rupees, 130 Singapore Dollars and 1.2 crore Indonesian Rupiah have been recovered this year till now," said an official. Personnel also recovered 80g of gold, gold jewellery, silver ornaments, 32

laptops, 68 mobile phones and nine watches, and returned them to their owners.

"Through meticulous screening, jawans intercepted and recovered four operational firearms and one round of live ammunition, stopping potential security threats," said the official, adding, working with Delhi Metro Rail Corporation and Childline, CISF personnel also rescued and reunited 69 missing children.
