2. As intimated by MHA, PMI to UN has informed about the invitation received from the UN for the Sixteenth Edition of the Women Outreach Course (WOC#16) scheduled to take place from 11 to 22 May 2026 at the United Nations Regional Service Centre in Entebbe, Uganda.

3. The course is a specialized training programme for women military signals and police information and communications technology (ICT) specialists. The programme directly responds to Security Council's Resolution 2122 (2013), which encourages troops and police-contributing countries to increase the percentage of women in military and police deployments to UN Peacekeeping Operations and address gender imbalance. It is designed to prepare female uniformed military and police officers for deployment in UN Peacekeeping Operations. The duration of the Women Outreach Course is two (2) weeks including basic UN training on C4-ISR plus cyber (Command, Control, Communication, Computer (C4), Cyber domains, information Management, Surveillance, Reconnaissance (ISR) systems and procedures, the collaboration between the WOC (C4-J6 Staff Officer) and an afternoon session covering an overview of micro-UAS fundamentals. The course includes real-time exercises built on a set of realistic scenarios. **The course will be conducted entirely in the English language.**

4. All costs associated with participating in the course (airfare, accommodation and meals) will be covered by the United Nations, enabled by generous donations from the Government of Canada. Obtaining Visas is the sole responsibilities (monetary and administrative) of participants. Participants must obtain all required transit and entry visas

before travel. It is mandatory for all participants to have international medical insurance for the duration of the course, including travel days. Local UN clinic will provide medical support for minor ailments (first aid). The provision of health insurance is a national responsibility. Participants who do not arrive on the first day of the training for circumstances other than unforeseen flight delays will not be accepted. Costs associated with late arrival (flight ticket, accommodation and meals) will be the responsibility of the participants' organization.

5. **No fixed slot from India is available. It is an open invitation for all members' states of UN.** The candidates should have a broad experience of police service, and are selected to serve as a police officer in an international peace support operation. The recommended nominees by Government of India will be selected by the UN.

6. MHA has further intimated that, the nomination of **eligible and suitable female candidates in the rank of Dy SP/SP active in police service** for the above said courses may be forwarded through proper channel to MHA by **26th Jan, 2026** along with the requisite documents duly signed and completed in all aspects as mentioned in Annexure-I & II. The nominations without Vigilance clearance and Cadre Clearance (for all Officers) from respective Ministries/Departments/State or UT/Organizations' shall be summarily rejected. Applications received through proper channel only i.e. through Home Department (State)/ approval of Head of Organization/ UT division in case of AGMUT cadre officers, will be entertained.

7. The duly completed and signed Bio-data in prescribed proforma, HR certificate along with the forwarding letter including APAR/ACR grading for the Last Five Years (Mandatory) of the nominated candidates are required to be submitted in a single PDF only before the last date of submission of nominations as mentioned above.


