Sub: **ALLOCATION OF CENTRAL POOL MBBS/BDS SEATS FOR WARDS OF CAPFS/AR PERSONNEL FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27: REG.**

It is intimated that every year, MHA/MoH&FW allocates MBBS/BDS seats under the Central Pool quota for the wards of CAPFs/AR personnel. The allocation of Central Pool MBBS/BDS seats for the Academic year 2026-27 is awaited from MHA/MoH&FW. In case of any amendment in the instructions/guidelines or the number of seats allocated for the wards of CAPFs/AR personnel, will be intimated immediately upon receipt from MHA/MoH&FW. During the Academic Session 2025-26, MHA/MoH&FW allocated 26 MBBS seats and 03 BDS seats under Central Pool quota.

02. Applications of eligible wards of Combatised Force personnel who have qualified National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET)-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.2026) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) are required to be forwarded to MHA under the Govt. Scheme for allocation of Central Pool MBBS/BDS seats for CAPFs/AR in the following priority categories:

- (i) **PRIORITY -I** : Wards of personnel those Killed in Action.
- (ii) **PRIORITY-II** : Wards of personnel those permanently disabled in action and boarded out from service.
- (iii) **PRIORITY -III** : Wards of all serving and retired personnel.

03. All the Sector IsG are requested to ensure that:

- i. The enclosed application format for submission of bio-data may be circulated to all HQrs./Estts./Units/BNs./RTCs under your jurisdiction including retired personnel of the respective sector.

ii. Each application shall be accompanied by self-attested copies of the following documents:

- a) Class X Certificate (proof of date of birth)
- b) Class XII Mark Sheet
- c) NEET-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.2026) Score Card/Result
- d) Undertaking
- e) Form-O
- f) Original Medical Fitness Certificate
- g) Caste Certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS), wherever applicable.

Copies of the prescribed formats of SC/ST/OBC (NCL) and EWS certificates are also enclosed.

- iii. It must also be ensured that wards of Force personnel applying for both courses i.e. **MBBS and BDS, will give separate application in duplicate for each MBBS and BDS seat and indicate their preference,** as per specimen enclosed and no columns to be left blank (if applicable to the student otherwise put (x) mark in appropriate columns).
- iv. On receipt of applications of wards of force personnel of your sector, same should be scrutinized, duly verified the NEET-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.2026) result from the official NTA website. Only eligible applications shall be forwarded to this Dte. in a consolidated category-wise proforma (General, OBC-Creamy Layer, OBC-Non Creamy Layer, SC, ST, EWS and PwD) separately for MBBS and BDS, **in MS Excel format only**, so as to reach this Directorate (Welfare Branch) **within 15 days of declaration of the NEET-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.2026) result** for further necessary action.
- v. It must also be kept in view that applications are accompanied by a merit list (as per enclosed proforma duly mentioning the above category i.e. **Priority-I, Priority-II & Priority-III**) in duplicate each for MBBS and BDS drawn in descending order duly countersigned by the Unit in-charge ensuring that information so furnished in the application form are correct in all respect.
- vi. Candidates must have secured the minimum qualifying percentile prescribed for NEET-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.26), as under:
 - a. General Category – **50** Percentile
 - b. SC/ST/OBC (NCL) – **40** Percentile
 - c. Persons with specified disabilities (General) – **45** Percentile
 - d. Persons with specified disabilities belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL) – **40** Percentile.

vii. The percentile shall be determined on the basis of the highest marks secured in the All India Common Merit List of NEET-2026 (Re-Examination held on 21.06.26) for admission to MBBS/BDS courses.

viii. Piecemeal, incomplete or incorrect application will not be entertained.

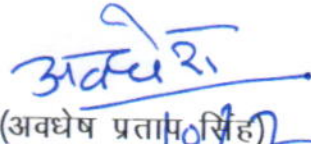
