with two golds, three silvers and two bronzes. On the men's side, CISF leads the medal tally with

three golds, two silvers and two bronzes. Border Security Force (BSF) are second with three golds, one silver and three bronze medals. Arunachal Pradesh Police has three golds to their credit.

The Taekwondo competition was conducted in two formats — Kyorugi (sparring) — contested across seven weight categories each for men and women — and Poomsae (forms), comprising individual and team events for both categories on the fifth day of the championship.
