Any one of the following valid photo identity documents is to be carried in original by the travelling passengers at the time of entry into the terminal building of the airports alongwith valid ticket.

- (i) Passport
- (ii) Voter Photo Identity card issued by Election Commission of India;
- (iii) Aadhaar or m-Aadhaar issued by Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAD
- (iv) PAN Card issued by Income Tax Department;
- (v) Driving License issued by RTO;
- (vi) Service Photo Identity Card issued by State/Central Government, public Sector Undertakings, Local bodies or Public Limited Companies;
- (vii) Student Photo Identity Cards issued by Government Institutions/Government recognized Educational Institutions;
- (viii) Nationalized Bank Passbook with attested photograph;
- (ix) Pension card/ Pension documents having photograph of the passenger;
- (x) Disability Photo ID Card/handicapped medical certificate issued by the respective State/UT Government/Administrations
- 2. There is no requirement of identify proof in respect of Infant/Minor accompanied by their parents/ guardian who is a bonafide passenger having a valid identity proof as listed above. However, an unaccompanied minor shall be required to produce a valid identity proof as listed above.
- 3. In case a passenger who for some valid reasons is not in a position to produce any of the above-list photo identify proof, the Identity Certificate issued by a Group 'A' Gazetted Officer of the Central/ State Government on his official letterhead with passenger's photograph duly attested will be valid for this purpose.
- 4. The international passenger must carry valid passport along with air ticket for entry to the terminal building
